Resolution CESNI 2024-II-4

Temporary Working groups in the field of vessel technical requirement

The European Committee for drawing up Standards in the field of Inland Navigation ("CESNI"),

having regard to Article 8 of its Rules of Procedure,

having regard to its Internal Regulations on Working groups,

having regard to its Resolutions 2017-III-1, 2018-I-2, 2020-I-1 and 2021-II-1,

resolves, at the request of the permanent Working group on technical requirements for inland navigation vessels (CESNI/PT), to

- disband the temporary Working group for electronic equipment and systems on board of inland navigation vessels (CESNI/PT/ELEC);
- update the mission of the temporary Working group on technical requirements for alternative fuels aboard inland navigation vessels (formerly for fuel cells) (CESNI/PT/FC), as defined in Annex 1;
- update the mission of the temporary Working group on the transitional provisions of the vessel technical requirements (CESNI/PT/DT) as defined in Annex 2;
- update the mission of the temporary Working group on the new model of vessel certificate (CESNI/PT/MOD) as defined in Annex 3.

**Mission of the temporary Working group on technical requirements
for alternative fuels aboard
inland navigation vessels
(CESNI/PT/FC)**

1. Mission

The CESNI work programme 2022-2024 envisages the following task: “To draft requirements for the use of alternative fuels on inland navigation vessels” (PT-1).

The objective is to ensure the safety and ease of navigation by inland navigation vessels using alternative fuels as the vessel’s propulsion systems or onboard power supply.

To this end, the CESNI/PT/FC temporary Working group has been tasked with preparing draft technical requirements for the use of alternative fuels aboard inland navigation vessels, including the bunkering, storage, distribution and processing of suitable primary fuels. The mission does not include developing requirements for vessel operation or crew training.

The CESNI/PT/FC temporary Working group has been tasked with:

- preparing the requirements for the use of compressed hydrogen in combustion engines;
- preparing the requirements for the storage and use of compressed natural gas, Liquid Organic Hydrogen Carriers (LOHC) and ammonia as a fuel once the experience of a pilot vessel is available;
- preparing any amendments to the requirements of the ES-TRIN made necessary in the light of the experience gained by the delegations and the industry.

In discharging its mission, the CESNI/PT/FC temporary Working group will build on a preliminary draft of the technical requirements prepared by the delegations , but also on the experience gained in the various countries with pilot projects for vessels.

The CESNI/PT/FC temporary Working group shall carry out its mission under the supervision of the CESNI/PT permanent Working group.

The CESNI/PT/FC temporary Working group will carry out its work in the period 2025-2027 with a view to incorporating the findings in ES-TRIN 2027/1 and ES-TRIN 2029/1.

4. Number and frequency of meetings

7 meetings of no more than one day's duration are planned for the period 2025-2027.

The number and duration of meetings shall only be increased in consultation with the CCNR Secretariat, upon agreement of the Working group CESNI/PT and in accordance with the multiyear financial agreement between the CCNR and the European Commission as referred to by Article 2, paragraph 4 of the Internal Regulations on working groups.

**Mission of the temporary Working group on the transitional provisions
of the vessel technical requirements (CESNI/PT/DT)**

1. Mission

The CESNI work programme 2025-2027 envisages the following task: “To review and simplify the transitional provisions for existing vessels, with the support of a temporary working group” (PT-11).

The objective is to prepare the revision of the transitional provisions laid down in Chapters 32 and 33 of ES-TRIN, as well as the associated regulatory frameworks, in view to simplify the application of ES-TRIN to existing vessels (for instance presentation of all transitional provisions in a single table). This work shall be carried out in accordance with the principles defined by the CESNI/PT Working group (see CESNI/PT (22) 14 rev. 2).

In the light of the work already carried out for the period 2022-2024, the CESNI/PT/DT temporary Working group has been tasked with finalising the draft amendments of Chapters 32 and 33 of ES-TRIN as well as to assess the impact of these amendments. In addition, the CESNI/PT/DT temporary Working group shall develop a tool to help the inspection bodies to monitor the expiry of the transitional provisions.

The CESNI/PT/DT temporary Working group shall carry out its mission under the supervision of the CESNI/PT permanent Working group.

1. Mission

The CESNI work programme 2022-2024 envisages the following task: “To draft a new model of inland navigation vessel certificate and the corresponding ESI instruction” (PT-10).

In the light of the preparatory work and the principles approved by the Working group CESNI/PT (CESNI/PT (20) 46 rev. 1 and CESNI/PT (21)m 22, point 7), as well as the work carried out by the Group of volunteers, the CESNI/PT/MOD temporary Working group has developed:

- a proposal of data fields to be included in the new model of certificate;
- a proposal for a new model of certificate (data fields and formatting).

For the period 2025-2027, the CESNI/PT/MOD temporary Working group has been tasked with revising the proposal for a new model certificate in the light of the comments made by the CESNI/P Working group;

- organising a workshop in view to seek the opinion of other stakeholders such as the profession and river polices, identify possible adaptations and ease acceptance of the new model of certificate;
- finalising the proposal for a new model certificate in the light of the comments from the workshop;
- preparing the corresponding ESI instruction.

The CESNI/PT/MOD temporary Working group shall carry out its mission under the supervision of the CESNI/PT permanent Working group.

The principal missions of the temporary Working group for **Electronic Reporting International (CESNI/TI/ERI)** shall be:

- to prepare proposals for the revision of the ES-RIS on the parts concerning **Electronic Reporting International** (including the operational and performance requirements, test methods and required results) as referred in CESNI's multi-annual work programme for 2025-2027;
- to provide advice regarding the proper implementation of the standards in the field of River Information Services (RIS) in particular regarding Electronic Reporting International or for other tasks in the work programme and relevant to the group's expertise, at the request of the Working group CESNI/TI;
- to provide advice and analyses relating to standards in the field of RIS, in particular regarding an electronic reporting system for inland navigation;
- to develop proposals and analyses for other tasks included in the work programme, at the request of the Working group CESNI/TI.

The temporary Working group CESNI/TI/ERI shall carry out its mission under the supervision of the permanent Working group on information technologies (CESNI/TI).

2. Composition

The temporary Working group CESNI/TI/ERI shall be composed of experts with a high level of expertise related to RIS and especially in the field of ERI, designated by the Members of CESNI referred to in Article 2 paragraphs, 1, 2 and 3 letter a, b, and c of the Rules of Procedure of the CESNI.

Individual experts referred to in Article 2 paragraph 3 letter d of the Rules of Procedure of the CESNI shall make themselves known to the Secretariat should they wish to participate in the work of the temporary Working group CESNI/TI/ERI.

As a matter of principle, the members of the temporary Working group CESNI/TI/ERI created by resolution 2019-II-6 and extended by resolution 2021-II-4 are renewed as members of the temporary Working group CESNI/TI/ERI that is the subject of this resolution.

The Secretariat shall thereafter be kept duly informed of any change regarding the composition of the temporary Working group CESNI/TI/ERI.

At least once a year, the composition of the group shall be updated and communicated to the Working group CESNI/TI for information.

3. Scheduling of work

The temporary Working group CESNI/TI/ERI shall start to work according to its mission described under paragraph 1, as from 1 January 2025, and shall complete its work at the latest upon expiry of the CESNI/TI work programme at the end of 2027.

4. Number and frequency of meetings

Ten meetings lasting no more than half a day are planned for 2025 to 2027.

The temporary Working group CESNI/TI/ERI will decide on a meeting schedule at its first meeting following the entry into force of this resolution in coordination with the Working group CESNI/TI and the other temporary working groups.

The number and frequency of meetings shall only be increased in consultation with the CCNR Secretariat, upon agreement of the Working group CESNI/TI and in accordance with the multi-year financial agreement between the CCNR and the European Commission as referred to by Article 2, paragraph 4 of the Internal Regulations on working groups.

5. Reports by the Chair of the temporary working group

In accordance with Article 3, paragraph 4 of the Internal Regulations on working groups, the Chair or, should he/she be unable to attend, the Vice-Chair of the temporary working group shall attend the meetings of the permanent Working group CESNI/TI and provide regular reports on the work of the temporary Working group CESNI/TI/ERI.

The Chair and Deputy-Chair of the temporary Working group CESNI/TI/ERI created by resolution 2019-II-6 and extended by resolution 2021-II-4 are tacitly reappointed on the date this resolution comes into force.

6. Support by the Secretariat

The Secretariat shall support the work of the temporary Working group CESNI/TI/ERI by:

- convening the meetings and providing support for documenting and communicating the results and the minutes of the meetings;
- providing support in preparing proposals to be submitted to the permanent Working group CESNI/TI and summary documents.

7. Working language

In accordance with Article 2, paragraph 2, letter e of the Internal Regulations on working groups, the temporary Working group CESNI/TI/ERI shall work in English. The proposals presented to the CESNI/TI Working group shall however be circulated in CESNI's four working languages, with the exemption of the parts of the proposals that are not to be translated.
